**Count 1**  
**AS 11.41.220(a)(5)(B)**  
**Assault in the third degree**  
**CTN 001**

That on or about October 1, 2025, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, James Herbert Carteeti did commit the crime of assault in the third degree if that person commits a crime that is a violation of AS 11.41.230(a)(1) or (2) and, within the preceding 10 years, the person was

1 convicted on two or more separate occasions of crimes under AS 11.41.200 —  
2 11.41.220, 11.41.230(a)(1) or (2), 11.41.280, or 11.41.282. All of which is a  
3 Class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS  
4 11.41.220(a)(5)(B) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

7 **Count 2**  
8 **AS 11.61.110(a)(1)**  
9 **Disorderly conduct**  
10 CTN 002

11 That on or about October 1, 2025, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial  
12 District, State of Alaska, James Herbert Carteeti did commit the crime of  
13 disorderly conduct if with intent to disturb the peace and privacy of another  
14 not physically on the same premises or with reckless disregard that the  
15 conduct is having that effect after being informed that it is having that effect,  
16 the person makes unreasonably loud noise. All of which is a Class B  
17 Misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.110(a)(1)  
18 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

21 **AS 11.56.700(a)(1)**  
22 **Resisting or interfering with arrest**  
23 CTN 002

24 That on or about October 1, 2025, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial  
25 District, State of Alaska, James Herbert Carteeti did commit the crime of  
26 resisting or interfering with arrest if, knowing that a peace officer is making an  
27 arrest, with the intent of preventing the officer from making the arrest, the  
28 person resists personal arrest or interferes with the arrest of another by force.  
29 All of which is a Class A Misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in  
30 violation of AS 11.56.700(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
31 Alaska.

**Count 4**  
**AS 11.56.757(a)(1)(2)(3)**  
**Violation of condition of release**  
CTN 002

That on or about October 1, 2025, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, James Herbert Carteeti did commit the crime of violation of condition of release if the person has been charged with a crime or convicted of a crime; has been released under AS 12.30; and (3) violates a condition of release imposed by a judicial officer under AS 12.30, other than the requirement to appear as ordered by a judicial officer. All of which is a Class B Misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.56.757(a)(1)(2)(3) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

**Count 5**  
**AS 11.41.220(a)(5)(B)**  
**Assault in the third degree**  
CTN 005

That on or about October 1, 2025, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, James Herbert Carteeti did commit the crime of assault in the third degree if that person commits a crime that is a violation of AS 11.41.230(a)(1) or (2) and, within the preceding 10 years, the person was convicted on two or more separate occasions of crimes under AS 11.41.200 — 11.41.220, 11.41.230(a)(1) or (2), 11.41.280, or 11.41.282. All of which is a Class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(5)(B) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

This complaint is based on the observation and written report of Officer Tristan Taber of the Juneau Police Department, which states, to wit:

1 On 10/01/2025, at 0041 hours a resident of Coho Apartments called the  
2 Juneau Police Department to report a neighbor in Coho Apartment 9B had  
3 very loud music and shaking things on C's walls.

4  
5 From prior contacts I knew the resident of that apartment to be James  
6 Carteeti. James had a warrant for his arrest per case 1JU-25-00556CR.  
7 Officer Johnston and Sgt. Dallas arrived on scene, and we approached  
8 building 9. When we arrived, we could hear loud music coming from  
9 apartment 9B. We knocked and announced "Juneau Police". James turned  
10 off the music, was yelling and hostile, answered the door and then slammed  
11 the door closed. James was told to keep the noise down. He continued to  
12 yell loudly on and off as we stood in the parking lot for several minutes.

13  
14 At 0114 hours we knocked on James's door and Sgt. Dallas was able to open  
15 the door and James was told he had a warrant for his arrest, and he rushed  
16 to shut the door on Sgt. Dallas. Sgt Dallas and Officer McCrumb were able to  
17 force the door open, and we all entered the residence.

18  
19 James began fighting more and we held him against the wall on the floor  
20 trying to get his arms behind his back. James was pulling his arms away and  
21 kicking during the arrest and kicked Officer McCrumb and Officer  
22 Thompson. James punched Officer McCrumb on the left side of his face,  
23 leaving a red mark and bending his glasses. Both Officer McCrumb and  
24 Officer Thompson said it hurt when they were hit. Officer Thompson had to  
25 be taken to Bartlett Regional Hospital for evaluation of his injury to his right  
26 arm.
